TEACHER-ASSISTED EXERCISES

- 1. Using the sources mentioned in section 2.1 above, try to write a biography of Karl Marx in which you explain how he came to writing his main economic work, the *Capital*.
- 2. Using the sources mentioned in sections 2.2 above, try to write your own interpretation of Marx's principles ideas.
- 3. Explore the <u>database</u> of the EE-T portal and the tools mentioned in section 5, to see how many translations were made in the world. Make a graph with the number of translations made in each decade from the 1870s until today. What does this graph indicate?
- 4. Searching the <u>database</u> of the EE-T portal and the tools mentioned in section 4, and using a world map or Google Maps "places I've visited" or similar tools, make a map of translations of the *The Capital* all over the world. What does this map indicate?
- 5. Is the database complete? Using Tribe's Guide and Library Catalogues, make or suggest entries.
- 6. Make a new entry in the EE-T Database, using an edition available in your library that is missing.
